



March 2, 2010 - The Glenview Village Board unanimously approved Baxter & Woodman's Contract to provide Engineering, Inspection and Maintenance Management Services for the next five years. The goal of the Village was to consolidate contractual services to one firm that will oversee these contracts for the Village. The first year base contract is \$2.25 million. Services provided directly by Baxter & Woodman includes capital improvement (roadway, sanitary sewer, water system and construction inspection) projects, water operations, ancillary design projects, and traffic engineering assistance.

Supporting the B&W Team are eight other subconsultants:

- ME Simpson – water meter testing;
- Backflow Solutions – water system cross connection control management;
- ILT Vignocchi – landscaping;
- Aquatic Ecological – water quality;
- Tall Grass Restoration – natural areas;
- Rickman Contract Services - water meter reading;
- Lyons-Pinner Electric – traffic signal maintenance;
- JAS Pacific – inspection management.

The organization chart proposed and accepted by Glenview contains more than 50 B&W professionals. The initial core team for B&W includes:
