Time and Place of Opening Bids. Sealed proposals for the construction of the 2010 Water System Improvements for the Village of Skokie, Cook County, Illinois, will be received at the Village Hall at 5127 Oakton Street, Skokie, Illinois until 11:00 A.M., Tuesday, February 23, 2010 and at that time will be publicly opened and unit price total read aloud.

Description of Work. The proposed construction consists of the installation of approximately 1,000 lineal feet of 8-inch and 965 lineal feet of 6-inch ductile iron water main; two 8-inch and three 6-inch gate valves; seven fire hydrants; one 8-inch non-pressure connection; four 6-inch non-pressure connections; 37 water service connections; complete surface restoration; and other miscellaneous items of work.

Not less than the prevailing rate of wages as found by the Village of Skokie or the Department of Labor or determined by the court on review shall be paid to all laborers, workmen and mechanics performing work under this contract.

If at the time the Agreement for this Project is executed, or if during the term of the Agreement, there is excessive unemployment in Illinois as defined in the Employment of Illinois Workers on Public Works Act, 30 ILCS 570/0.01 et seq., as two consecutive months of unemployment exceeding five percent (5%), the Bidder agrees to employ Illinois laborers in accordance with the "Employment of Illinois Workers on Public Works Act". An "Illinois laborer" is defined as any person who has resided in Illinois for at least thirty (30) days and intends to become or remain an Illinois resident.

The Village of Skokie is exempt from the Illinois State, municipal or county Retailers Occupation Tax, Service Occupation Tax, Use Tax, and Service Use Tax as described in Illinois Compiled Statute Chapter 35. Bid prices shall not include the cost of such taxes.

All Bids must be accompanied by a Bidder's bond, certified check, bank cashier's check or bank draft payable to the Village of Skokie for five percent (5%) of the total amount of the Bid as provided in the Bidder Instructions.
