Launched in April in partnership with Door Dash, the Ride United Last-

Mile Delivery initiative has distributed more than **100,000 food boxes and household supplies** to vulnerable populations throughout 175 U.S. communities.



Your donations helped Water for People distribute **100 Sustainable Sanitation units** to nine municipalities of Cochabamba, Bolivia. Under this model, the families use the donated units to build their own bathrooms with the guidance of municipal technicians.
