



PROJECT BACKGROUND

Lake County Division of Transportation initiated the My Commute Lake County Study to examine opportunities to reduce single occupancy vehicle travel in the County. The study included stakeholder coordination to review national best practices and opportunities.

STRATEGIC SOLUTIONS

Our team supported AECOM to conduct a comprehensive study that utilized a multi-faceted stakeholder engagement campaign with public, local agency and national agency input.

The study sought to create different types of subregions within Lake County that recommendations could be developed and replicated in similar demographics across the County. To accomplish this goal, the team worked with a stakeholder group to help develop and evaluate recommendations.

The team also interviewed local and national transit agencies to determine best practices and opportunities for collaboration. Finally, a public survey and business survey were utilized to gather details about employee travel preferences and employer plans.

KEY TAKEAWAYS

Interviews and stakeholder meetings with local transit agencies helped the study team identify opportunities that the County could utilize to implement different recommendations. This connection also allowed the County to discuss opportunities for transit service improvements as travel resumed post pandemic.
