STREETS, SIDEWALKS & FLOODING REFERENDUM

- On the November 3, 2020 election ballot, the Village will seek voter approval to sell \$10 million in general obligation bonds to finance street, sidewalk and stormwater improvements.
- The Village does not have enough funding to complete much-needed street and sidewalk projects. Without a significant investment in the program, annual street resurfacing will fall further behind.
- A portion of the GO bonds will also be used to address flooding issues at the Flossmoor Road viaduct and areas upstream, if grants are not received. If grants are awarded, more of the bond will be dedicated to street resurfacing and sidewalk repairs.
- Because the debt the Village issued to build the Flossmoor Public Library will be paid off in 2021, **taxpayers will be paying about the same as they are now.**
- Street resurfacing work will begin as early as 2021, and the viaduct project will begin as soon as the grant status is known.
