SUBJECT: November Referendum on Streets, Sidewalks and Flooding

In your packet, you will find the following materials to use when walking door-to-door to educate the community about the November 3, 2020 bond referendum on streets, sidewalks and flooding.

1. Map of your assigned precincts and a Village address map.
2. The November 2012 and 2018 election results by precinct. The information will tell you how the precinct voted in the water bond referendum and the non-home rule sales tax referenda. The 2012 precincts were slightly different in 2012: Rich 39 is now a part of Rich 3.
3. Door hangers; if you need more, please let us know.
4. A copy of the talking points; frequently asked questions for your reference; and the 3 maps/street listings depending upon the bond allocation.

The walking assignments have been divided according to precincts. We tried to make them as even as possible and centered around where you live. Thank you to the CRC members agreeing to help the Board; we may still have a couple more who step up to help. Your walking assignments are as follows.

Clerk Billings	Rich 41
Trustee Bradley-Scott & Rosalind Mustafa (CRC)	Rich 45, Rich 3 east of Kedzie Avenue
Trustee Driscoll	Bloom 1
Trustee Hoag	Rich 31 and Rich 29 south to Flossmoor Road
Trustee Mitros & Jackie Riffice (CRC)	Rich 29 north to Flossmoor Road and
Trustee Kimmons	Bloom 50
Trustee Williams	Rich 6

If a trustee has a good relationship with any of the multi-family areas to get into the buildings, please suggest a trade. You are welcome to walk in groups of two or trade some areas if you'd like. If you can't walk your entire assignment, please contact me.
